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ABOUT THE COURSE

This introductory course in childcare aims to orient caregivers to the fundamental concepts of Child Development. The material is intended for use with children between the ages of 0-5 years of age.

- To understand the impact of early childhood years and the significance of early childhood education.
- To understand the meaning of curriculum and the various components for young children.
- To understand the laws and regulations for Childcare in Guvana.
- To orient participants on their roles and responsibilities as a teacher/care giver.
