ABOUT THE COURSE

Through a comprehensive curriculum that spans five detailed modules, participants will explore the intricate world of human rights, with a special focus on the rights of the child, learning to navigate the legal frameworks, recognize and respond to violations, and conduct thorough and sensitive investigations
