WHAT WILL I LEARN?

- Unit 2 (30 credits) Project and Operations Management

- Business Dissertation (60 credits)

The learning delivery takes place through a mix of interactive lectures, seminars, and tutorials, along with guided learning, independent and autonomous learning. This emphasis on active learning uses the latest in teaching and learning approaches.
